

This is a list of suggested materials that your first grade child should keep in their designated virtual learning area.

Technology:

-a chrome book or other device

***Please inform your child's teacher or the school office if your child does not have their own device to use for their schoolwork. Devices cannot be shared with siblings.**

-Wi-Fi access

***Please inform your child's teacher or the school office if your child does not have Wi-Fi access.**

-access to a printer, if possible, to print out hard copies of assignments.

Teacher Requested Supplies:

-a pair of headphones

-white copy paper

-notebook paper

-a pencil box or container to store materials in

-crayons

-scissors

-glue sticks

-a ruler

-a highlighter

-erasers for pencils

-a whiteboard

-a dry erase marker

-a whiteboard eraser or sock

-pencils

-a pencil sharpener

-a primary lined composition book (preferably with a blank area at the top of each page for the child to draw a picture to write about).

-25 counters in a zipper top bag (These will be used for math. Counters can be similar coins, cubes, beans, pasta, etc.)
